Twin single, queen or king for 30 people in 15 rooms

Modest and clean accommodation in a rainforest setting.
Configurable to king singles, twin or double rooms.
Spacious lounge room centrally located.
Private spaces to relax on the large wrap around verandah with access from every room.



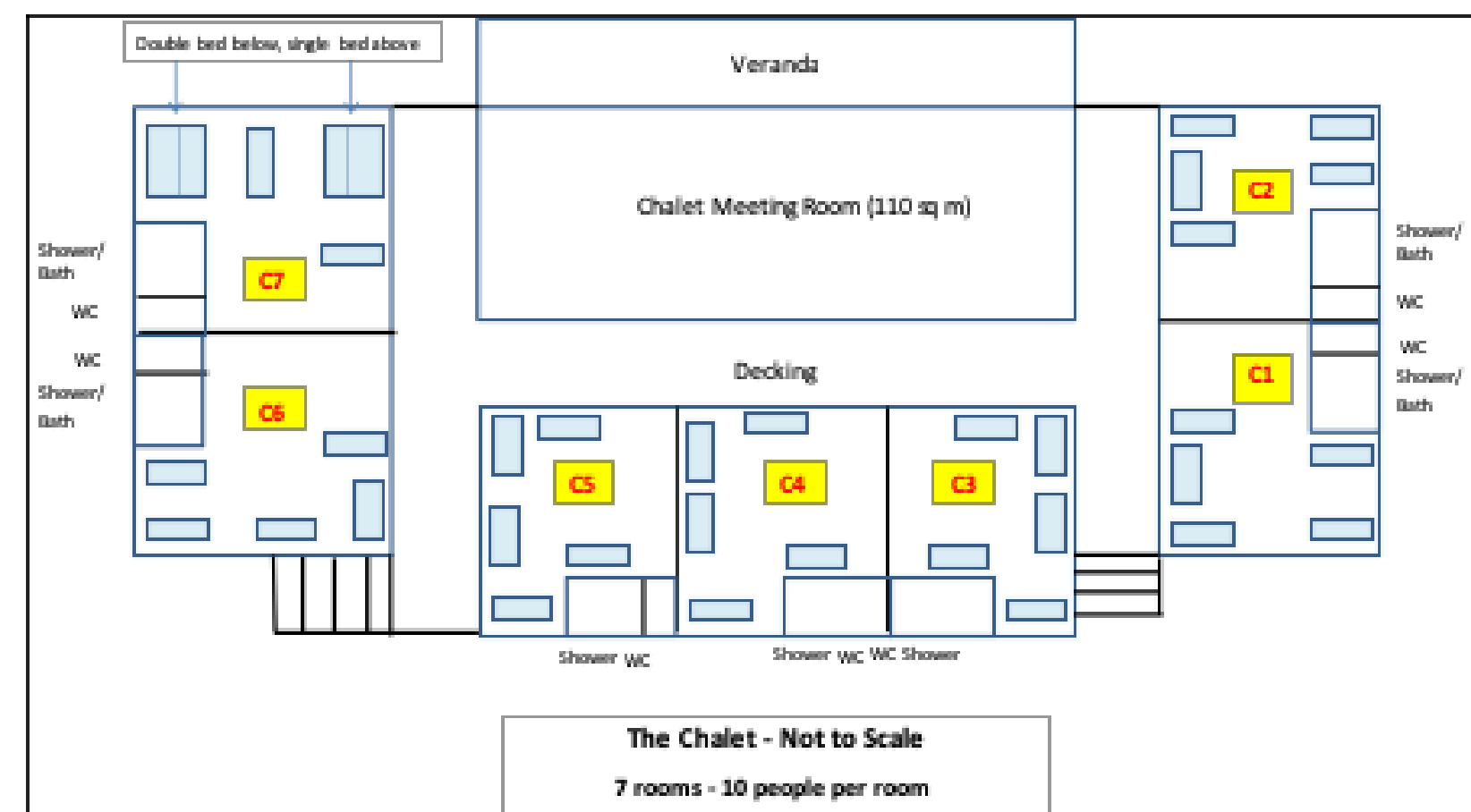
The Chalet

Bunk accommodation for 70 people
7 rooms each with 10 bunks (5 double bunks)
Separate toilet and ensuite bathroom in each room
Wrap around verandas in the rainforest canopy
100m2 large meeting room for a workshop space
and tuition hall - fully air conditioned
Great views of the surrounding ridges



The Chalet

The perfect mixture of nature, comfort and affordability.
Suitable for large groups, families, school groups and economic budgets.
Closest accommodation to the main walking trails.

Walk-in cool room and freezer room
Large pantry for dry food storage
2 commercial gas stoves with ovens
1 deep freeze unit

4 sinks and cleaning items
2 microwaves

Dining Hall & Guest Lounge

Very large space - 315 m2 for dining, lounging and for running workshops for large groups

Seating and cutlery for over 100

Normally divided into dining area + lounge

Several pedestal fans

Large slow combustion fire place

Opens on to 27 m long wrap around veranda

Views for sunrise and sunset



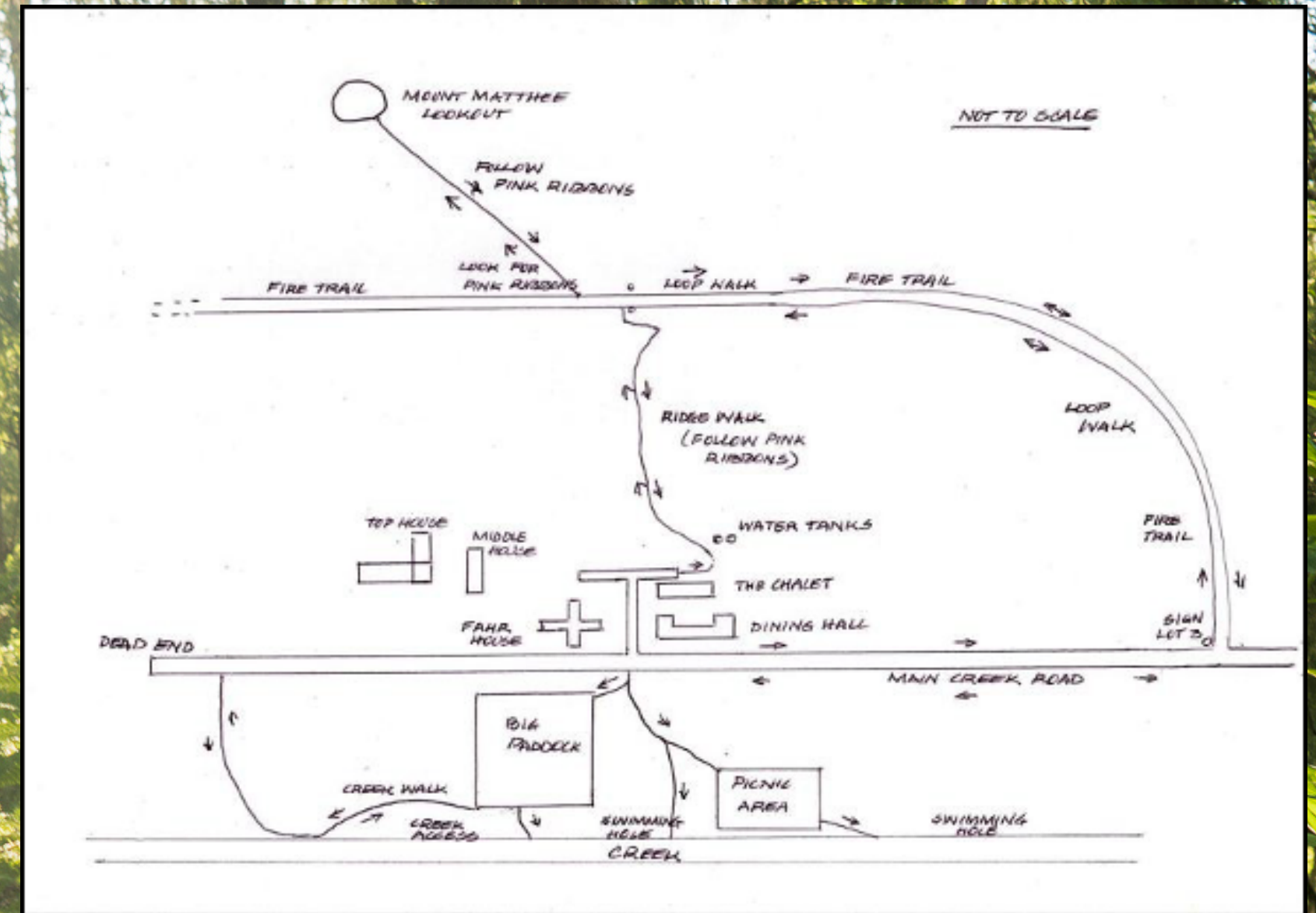
Walking Trails
